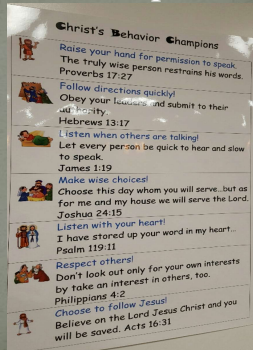

Positive Discipline

- Ephesians 6:4
 - Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.
- Proverbs 13:24
 - Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him

Positive Discipline

- 4 Step Discipline Process
 - Leadership Handbook pg. 33-35
 1. Talk with the child privately
 2. Take disciplinary action you agreed upon
 3. Bring child to Director or Immediate Supervisor
 4. Bring child to Pastor and Parent Conference will be arranged

Management Strategies

- Be Prepared
 - Students will take advantage of down time
- Routines and Expectations
 - Agenda
- Giving Directions
 - 1-2 steps at a time
 - examples
- Calling Attention
 - Hand claps
 - "If you can hear me"
 - Affirmation works well with most students
- Pick and choose battles
 - Some things can be quietly handled
